



PALOUSE WISESCAPE AWARD *...for water-conserving landscaping*

The Wisescape Award was established in 2008 to promote water-efficient landscaping on the Palouse and to recognize individuals who set examples for aesthetics and resource conservation. The following guidelines are used for eligibility:

- **Design**
 - Aesthetically pleasing (Looks nice during various seasons)
 - Practical (Designed for efficient resource use)
 - Limit traditional Turf (Limited use of turf and/or water-conserving varieties)
 - Plant zoning (Plants with similar needs together, appropriately placed)
 - Efficient irrigation (Manual and/or automatic; creative capture/reuse systems as authorized)
- **Reduce Resource Use**
 - Water Savings (Reduced volume during peak season)
 - Less mowing (Savings in energy and fuel; reduction in biomass for disposal)
 - Labor savings (Savings in time and/or money)
 - Fertilizer savings (Diminished leaching of fertilizer into surface and storm water systems)
 - Pesticide savings (Diminished leaching of pesticides into surface and storm water systems)
 - Reduction in yard waste (On-site retention and/or composting)
- **Soil**
 - Enhancements (Compost, mulches, etc.)
- **Plant Selection**
 - Site-appropriate plants (Suitably selected and placed within landscape)

Eligibility

- Nominees must reside in _____

- Landscapes and irrigation systems must comply with local ordinances and resolutions.
